I conducted legal research and analysis on international crimes, state responsibility, and universal jurisdiction; contributed to official communications and submissions to international courts. I also strengthened skills in legal research, case law analysis, and legal English.

My work was focused on the situations in Palestine and Libya, supporting the team through case-specific research and the preparation of legal briefs and related documentation.

I graduated in Law School in April 2025 with a thesis in International Criminal Law titled "The Application of the Principle of Universal Jurisdiction: Prosecution of International Crimes in Germany and in Italy."

In this work, I explored the principle of universal jurisdiction, starting from a historical and legal analysis, and focusing on its application in Germany—particularly in relation to crimes committed in Syria—and in Italy, with specific attention to the Libyan context.
